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Spring Green Fire Protection District
Regular Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, September 16, 2025 – 5:30pm

Dave called the meeting to order at 5:30pm. He asked Sondra if there was a legal posting of the meeting of which she said there was. Roll Call was taken with the following attending – Dave Radel, Greg Prem, Dick Cates, Lin Gunderson, Derek Miller, Jaime Radtke & Sondra Anliker. Dave asked for a motion to adopt the Agenda – Dick made a motion and Greg 2nd. Agenda approved.

Secretary's report – Sondra sent out the minutes from our July 15, 2025 meeting ahead of time and Greg made a motion to approve the minutes with a 2nd from Dick. Minutes approved. Sondra stated she has spoken with Sam at Johnson & Block regarding the audit and he said they are nearing completion of the audit. He emailed copies of Drafts of 2 of the documents they have prepared. He also emailed several other documents that they have prepared and Sondra will send those out to the board members to look over. Sondra will also speak with Sam to see how soon he thinks the audit will be completed and ask if he would be able to attend the November board meeting to go over the audit with us. Greg made a motion to approve the secretary's report and Dick 2nd. Report approved.

Treasurer's report – To save time due to this being our Budget meeting Sondra sent out the Account Balance report, the General Leger, Fire & Ambulance Budget vs Actual reports. Greg made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report and Dick 2nd. Report approved.

Fire Report – Recently there were issues with 3 of the overhead doors (motors) failing, Garage Door Express repaired them. Tanker 1 is back from having the repairs done and Lin has sent the bill to the insurance company. Rennerts and Great Lakes testing will be here on 9/24 to conduct annual testing/preventative maintenance on the trucks. AV equipment has all been installed in the large meeting room for a final cost of around \$23,000. \$17,000 was donated toward the cost of this project. John Novak who is one of our EMT's and his wife did the painting of the wall. Candidate Thomas Freel was started in the Entry Level FF class in Loganville on August 4th. Matt Johnson was voted onto the dept. Matt has prior experience and is certified. Local night was held at the Shed on Sept. 8 with a good turnout. Close to \$5000 was brought in plus funds from the "Fill the Boots" and the 50/50 raffle. Lin stated that he would like to start working on the replacement of Squad 1 which is a year 2000, and the Tender 2 which is a 1994. Lin mentioned that there is a very good video on YouTube – Senate hearing on Rising Cost of Fire Apparatus if anyone is interested. Dick made a motion to approve the Fire Report and Greg 2nd. Report approved.

Ambulance Report – Derek reported that Michael Broh had a brain tumor and has had surgery and is currently having chemo treatments. At this point Michael is not sure when or if he will be able to come back on the Ambulance crew. He is doing well. Susan Washa who was formerly on the Ambulance Crew for many years has once joined the crew and will be able to take some day calls as well as one night a week. We are very happy to have Susan back on the crew with us. Call volume so far in 2025 is 283 which is on pace for 397 for the year. Derek is looking to upgrade the grilled guard and repair the back doors of the older ambulance which would be a cost of approx. \$12,600. They have not purchased any uniforms this year but are considering

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purchasing reflective EMS vests at a cost of approx. \$2000. Considering using Ambulance Fund money for the purchase. Stryker came and service the LifePaks – one is out of support at this point. It is still working with no problems. A replacement unit would be a LifePak50 at approx. \$50k. Planning to use existing one for a while yet. Fundraiser account balances are – Ambulance Fund \$41,617.29 and the Dance Fund is at a balance of \$119,539.08. Dick made a motion to approve the Ambulance report and Greg 2nd. Report approved.

With all reports and business taken care of we continued on with preparing the 2026 Budget. It was decided to meet again on October 21 at 5:30pm to complete the budget and finalize due to the fact we had already been working on it for 3 hours this evening.

Future items at the October meeting will be to finalize raises for Officers on the Fire Dept. as well as raises for Derek and Jaime and finalizing Sondra's raise.

Greg made a motion to adjourn the meeting and meet again on October 21 and Dick 2nd. Meeting adjourned at 8:45.
